Singing opportunities for children - Cathedral Choirs

Children have the opportunity to participate in the Cathedral Choirs from Year 1. The Junior Choir for children in years 1 - 4 rehearses on a Monday. No audition is necessary to join. The Cathedral Choir is open to children in years 3 - 8, and sings during term time and special services. The benefits of singing and a musical education are well documented, improving language development, self-confidence, and team-working. The Cathedral employs a number of music professionals to ensure that each child receives a fantastic and bespoke music education.
